INTRODUCTION

This list includes all active transportation projects within the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) area that include federal funds obligated within fiscal year (FY) 2007. Both roadway and transit projects are included. The RTC fiscal year runs from July 1 to June 30; FY 2007 includes the period from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

This document is published by the RTC in accordance with federal law. The Safe, Accountable, Flexible and Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users, enacted as Public Law 109-59 on August 10, 2005, included the provision that all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs), such as the RTC, must develop this list.

An annual listing of projects for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the categories identified in the transportation improvement program. (Title 23 U.S.C. 134 (h)(7)(B))

The projects listed are those that the federal agency has authorized through the cooperative local and state level planning process. The relevant federal agencies are usually the Federal Highway Administration or Federal Transit Administration, but may include other federal funding sources from time to time. All projects are listed in the State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP), produced by the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), and the RTC's *Regional Transportation Plan FY 2006-2030/Transportation Improvement Program FY 2007-2010*. The list includes those projects for which funding has been obligated within this period; actual completion of the project may be accomplished within the fiscal year or extend into subsequent years.

The projects are organized into two sections. The NDOT's list covers street and highway-related projects and includes the NDOT unique project number; RTC's transit-related projects are in the latter part of the list with the RTC identification number shown.
